- Are fluid
- Require trial and evaluation approach
- Information needs to be shared as to what works and what does not
- Need to be reviewed continuously

Administrative and Operational issues

- Identify the resources required
- Engage everyone in the activity
- Monitor the change or adaptation
- Provide support for faculty and students in the process
- Ownership of the best practice model
- Encourage and foster a culture of research to improve learning
