Hundreds of students participated in a districtwide trial of *Reading Horizons Discovery*® over a period of five months. Students in the trial schools averaged higher average Lexile measure gains than students in the control schools.

The first and second grade classrooms that used the program the most throughout the school year showed fewer students needing intensive reading instruction on the Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS).



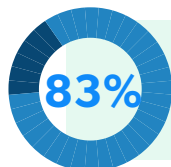
