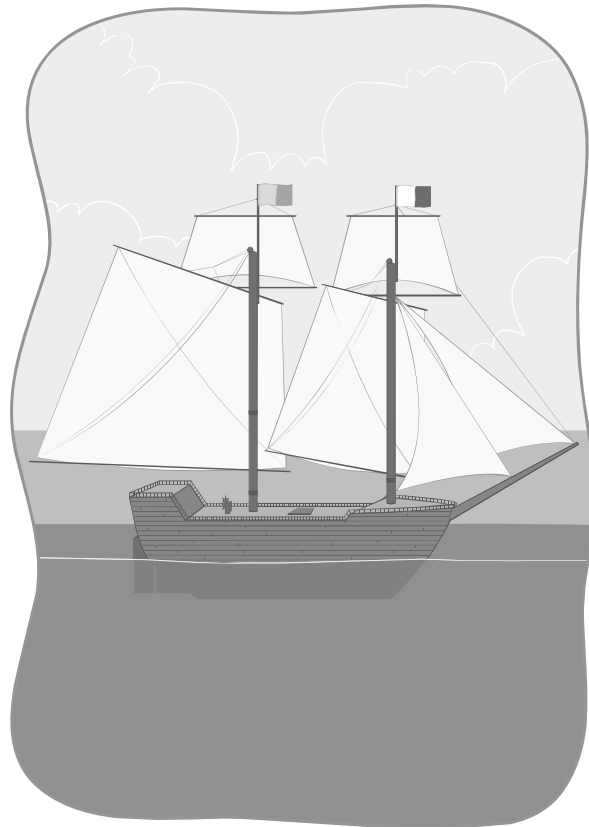
Based on *Reading Horizons Discovery® Little Book "Parts of a Ship"*
