

Consonant *B*

The name of this letter is *b*. *B* is a consonant. The sound of *b* is /b/, as in *bug*.

### Lesson 3: Consonant *B*

Write rows of the letter *b* matching the example at the beginning of each row. Each time you write a letter, say the name and the sound: *b*, /b/; *b*, /b/.




When a consonant and a vowel are joined together, "slide" the sounds together. Remember to read the slide from left to right. The mark or arrow beneath the letters is called a slide arrow. It is a reminder to keep the sounds together.

### Lesson 4: The Slide

Write a row of the lowercase *a*. Say the sound each time you write it.
