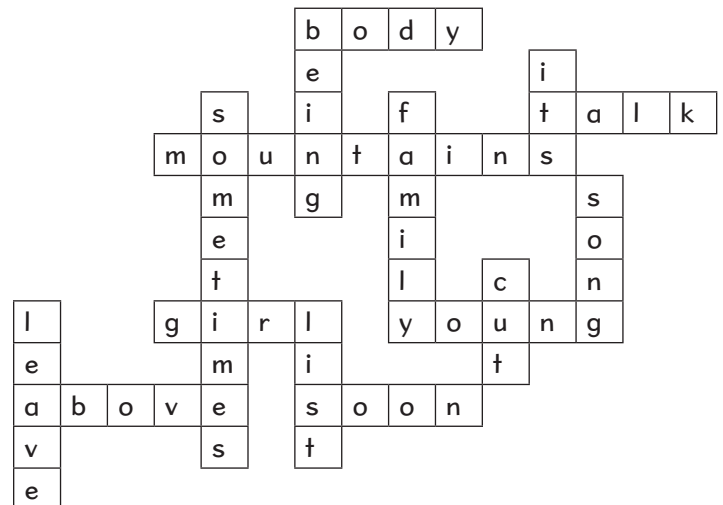
Lesson 84: Most Common Words List 20
